HAIN "could face Police investigation"



Mystery over £100,000 donation

Failed Labour deputy leadership candidate and cabinet minister Peter Hain could face a Police enquiry into over £100,000 of undeclared donations to his campaign. Mr Hain, who has two cabinet jobs - he is Secretary of State for Work and Pensions, and Secretary of State for Wales - is also facing an investigation by House of Commons authorities. An official from the Standards Office has stated that he believes that there are grounds for an official investigation. Part of the investigation is concerned with a so-called "think tank" which has produced no reports, employs no staff, and is apparently based at a solicitor's office, but which provided substantial sums to Mr Hain's campaign.

Overcrowded Britain?

Independent research group Migrationwatch UK says Labour's policies will bring 7.2 million new residents into Britain in the next 20 or so years; reports from the Centre for Urban & Regional Studies at the University of Birmingham says the extra strain is affecting local council services, particularly in housing and education, and is leading to increases in Council Tax.

Almost 2million new homes will have to be built just to cope with the influx, says a report to the House of Lords. 263 houses must be built every day for almost 20 years – the equivalent of 5 cities the size of Birmingham over the next 18 years.

The extent to which bogus colleges are being used to help illegal entrants come into Britain was exposed on Tuesday. Almost half the colleges visited by inspectors have been struck off an official list of approved providers. Some were removed for "technical" reasons, but many others are understood to be fronts for student visa scams. 256 colleges have been checked since the register was set up three years ago, and 124 have been removed.

1,750 colleges have not yet been inspected.

Immigration officers have been ordered to stop deporting foreign students who overstay their visas. A leaked memo obtained by a national newspaper suggests they are not regarded as a high enough priority, yet 1.6million student visas have been handed out in the last five years. No figures are available on overstayers because no checks are made on who leaves Britain.

New border force will stop illegal entry

The Conservatives have pledged to create a new border security force to clamp down on illegal immigration, and prevent the extra strain put on schools, hospitals and housing. At the same time, legal immigration will be subject to a limit, based on the skills that Britain needs.

More help to fight cancer

Inheritance Tax reforms

Conservatives will raise the Inheritance Tax threshold to £1 million, and take the family home out of inheritance tax. Nine million families will benefit, and you will not be punished for working hard and saving hard, and for wanting a better life for your children.

Help for first time buyers & families

Anyone who buys their first home for under £250,000 will pay no stamp duty under the Conservatives. We will take 200,000 people a year out of stamp duty altogether.
