CLLR AXED AFTER COUP BY FORMER CANDIDATE

The Netherton Labour party is in disarray yet again after a second local councillor has been forced to step down due to the ruthless ambition of one of their former candidates Qadar Zada.

Withymoore Road – MP Chris Kelly urges Severn Trent “Get it sorted!”

Chris Kelly MP and Councillor John Davies have been inundated with complaints from residents from Withymoore Road. Several times now over many years sewer pipes leading to their homes have been blocked.

Chris Kelly MP said: “The response of Severn Trent to the residents and myself has been unacceptable. It is clear the primary cause is the blockage of the main public sewer.”

Councillor John Davies added: “The concerns of residents can be allayed by Severn Trent putting a camera down the main sewer pipe and then making the official report available to councillors, the MP and local residents.”

Chris Kelly MP has written to both the local authority and Severn Trent to request a permanent solution to this long standing problem.

The mail bags of both Chris Kelly MP and Cllr John Davies were full last year with complaints of noise and anti social behaviour on Friday & Saturday nights. The MP’s office and Cllr Davies contacted Dudley’s licensing officers and demanded action for long suffering residents of Baptist End Road.

Chris Kelly MP said: “I wrote to the Council and they agreed to instruct the licensee to place notices requesting customers leave in a quiet manner so that residents in Baptist End Road are not kept awake by the noise of revellers going home.”

Cllr John Davies said: “We will continue to work with the Licensing team, Police and residents to ensure that the good work they have achieved is continued and that they have peace of mind at weekends. Although none of us want another pub to close and we wish the licensee well, the quality of life for local people must come first. The general view is that customers are now leaving the area quietly and respecting the wishes of residents.”
